## **NEW ADDITION TO BANK OF CANADA MUSEUM**

THE BANK OF CANADA HAS ACQUIRED AN ULTRA RARE MILITARY BANKNOTE BEING THE ONLY ONE OF ITS KIND KNOWN TO EXIST. THE \$1 DOLLAR BILL WAS ISSUED IN 1813 BY THE BILL OFFICE IN QUEBEC CITY TO FINANCE THE WAR OF 1812. THE FIRST ISSUE OF 1812 WERE IN \$4, \$25, \$50, \$100 AND \$400 DENOMINATIONS, BUT BY 1813 A SECOND ISSUE OF SMALLER DENOMINATIONS OF \$1, \$2, \$8, \$10, \$12, \$16 AND \$20 BILLS WERE ISSUED OF WHICH THIS IS ONE. WITH THE END OF THE WAR IN 1815, THE BRITISH GOVERNMENT REDEEMED THEM IN FULL PAVING THE WAY FOR THE MODERN BANKING SYSTEM.
